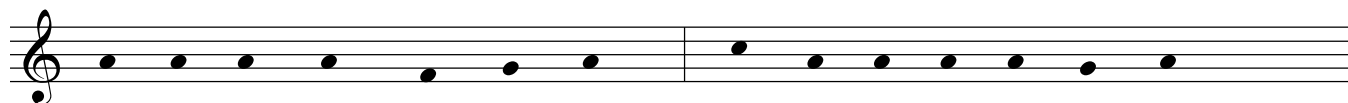


Christmas Gospel: Luke 2:1-14 (or 1-20)

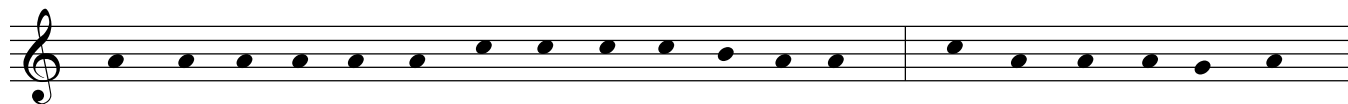

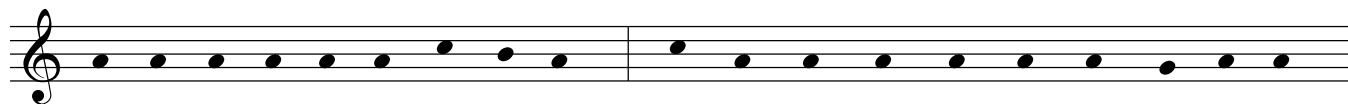
And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a de-cree from Cae-sar Au-gus-tus,



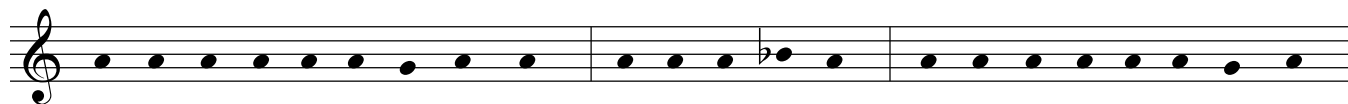
that all the world should be taxed. (And this tax-ing was first made



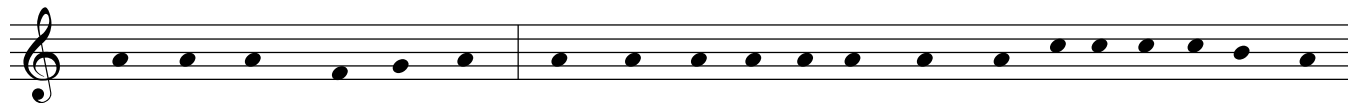
when Cy-re-ni-us was gov-er-nor of Syr-i-a.) And all went to be taxed,



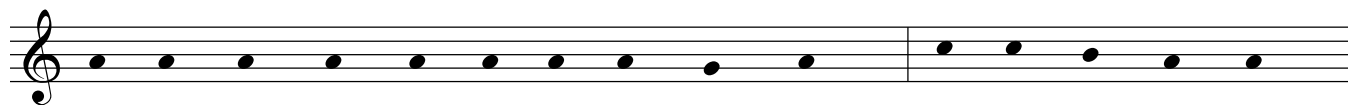
ev'-ry one in-to his own cit-y. And Jo-seph also went up from Gal-i-lee,



out of the ci-ty of Na-za-reth, in-to Ju-de-a, un-to the ci-ty of Da-vid,



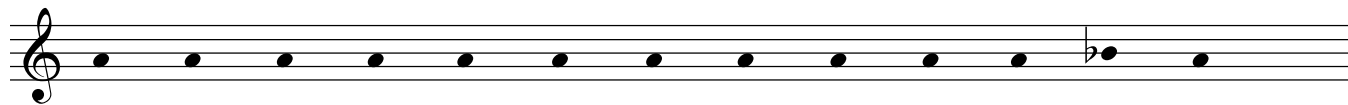
which is called Beth-le-hem; (be-cause he was of the house and lin-e-age of Da-vid:)



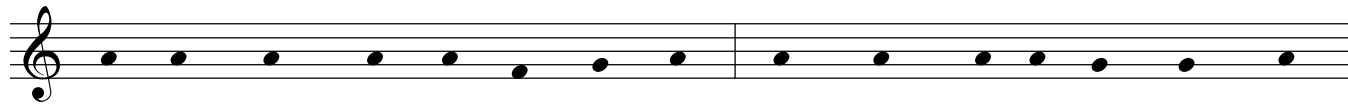
To be taxed with Mar-y his es-poused wife, be-ing great with child.



And so it was, that, while they were there,



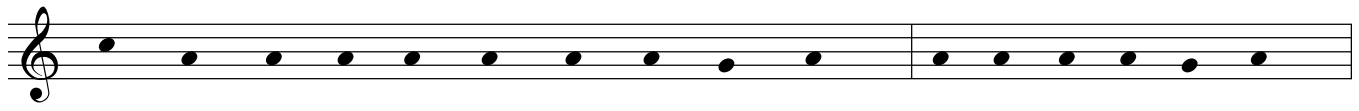
the days were ac-com-plished that she should be de-liv-ered.

keep - ing watch o - ver their flock by night. And, lo, the an - gel of the Lord came up - on them,



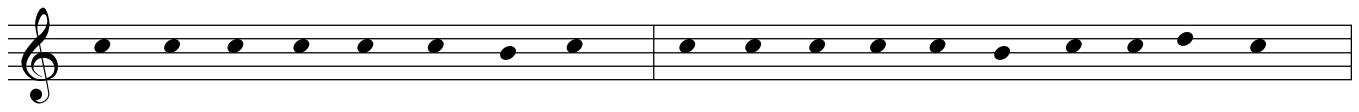
and the glo - ry of the Lord shone round a - bout them: and they were sore a - fraid.



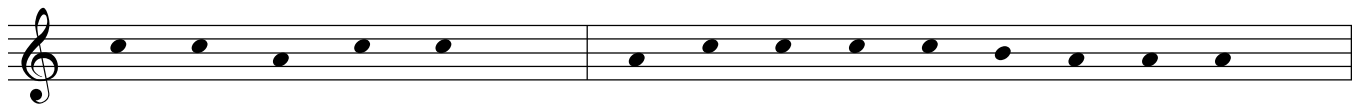
And the an - gel said un - to them, Fear not: for, be - hold,



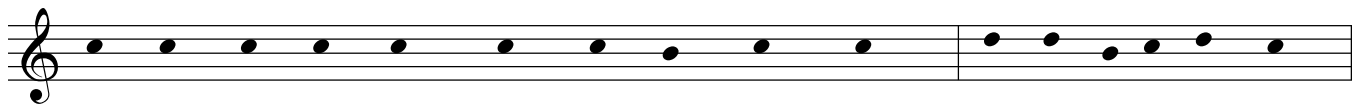
I bring you good ti - dings of great joy, which shall be to all peo - ple.



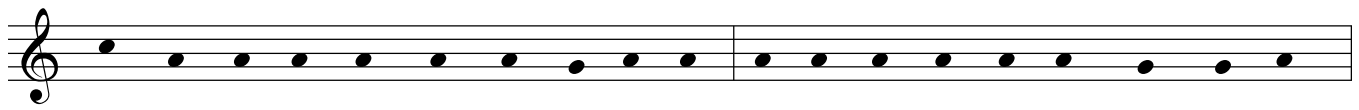

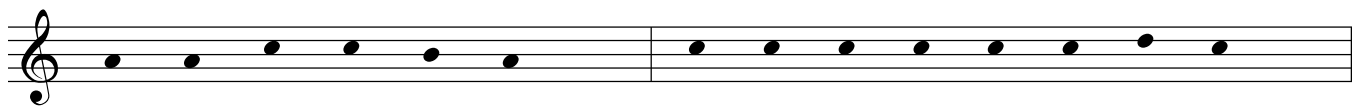
which is Christ the Lord. And this shall be a sign un - to you;



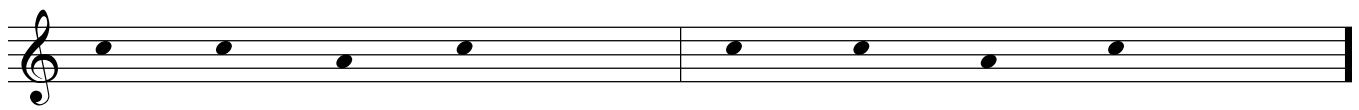

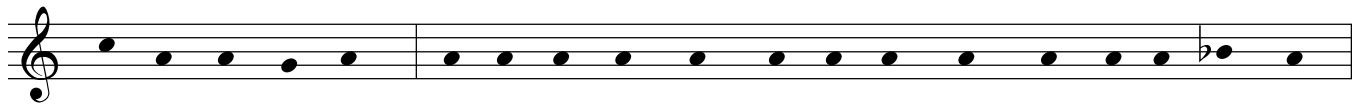
And sud - den - ly there was with the an - gel a mul - ti - tude of the heav' n - ly host



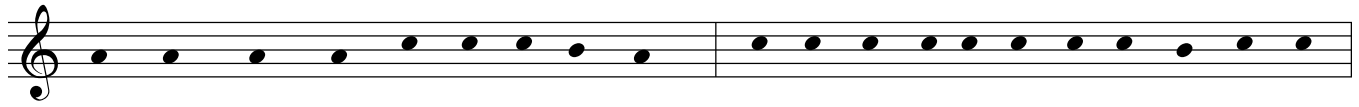
prais - ing God, and say - ing, Glo - ry to God in the high - est,

the shep-herds said one to an - o - ther: Let us now go e-ven un-to Beth-le-hem



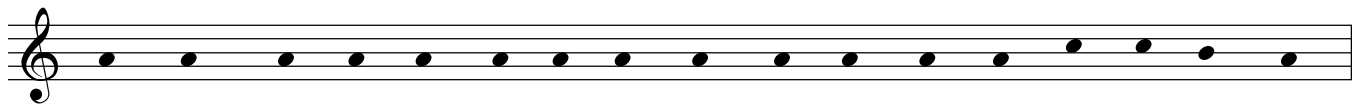
and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known un-to us.



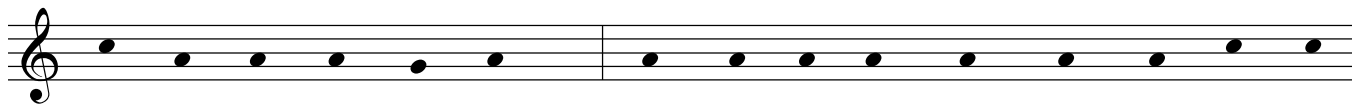
And they came with haste, and found Mar - y and Jo - seph,



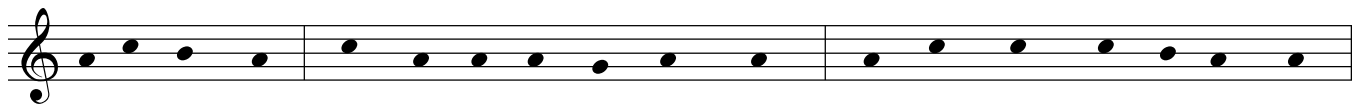
and the Babe, ly - ing in a man-ger. And when they had seen it,



they made known a-broad the say-ing which was told them con-cern-ing this Child.



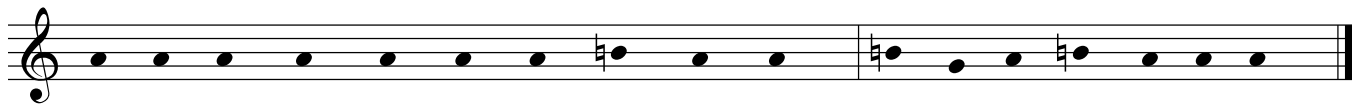
And all they that heard it won-dered at those things which were told them
